Wild Kayak Expedition

Pre Expedition information:

The Wild Kayak Expedition journeys along a beautiful stretch of the South Devon coastline. The expedition is run on Sit On Top Kayaks, Stable and easy to paddle these craft allow us to take the novice paddler into remote marine environments. Here you will have the opportunity to explore our rugged coastline up-close and personal with limited previous experience or training. During the journey we may be able to have a go a hand line fishing from the kayaks. Whilst we don't rely on this to support our evening meals we do, if successful, cook the catch to complement our meal. Our highly experienced and qualified guides will set a route to maximise your enjoyment of the experience.

The Route and Meeting Location:

The route will be decided in the days leading up to each course. The route will be chosen to provide the best 'safe' experience based on the conditions. During adverse conditions the decision may be made to change the location, in exceptional circumstances the trip may need to be cancelled (see separate T&C's). Irrespective of the route the meet location will be the Seashore Centre, Tanners Road, Paignton TQ4 6LP. Arrival time on day 1 will be 09.30 and the Departure time the following day will be 16.00. During the months of April – October there is a pay and display car park in operation here. Free off-road parking can be found on neighbouring streets.

What's you are required to bring:

Breakfast Day 1, Lunch for Day 1

Sleeping Bag,

1 complete set of clothes for camp

1 complete set of clothes to Paddle in

1 complete spare set of Clothes

Trainers or sandals to get wet.

Sunscreen, Sun Hat, Warm Hat

Swim wear

Personal Toiletries

Head Torch

Dry footwear for camp.

Snacks for sustenance

Drinks Bottle 1L

Excess kit leads to additional weight to carry. Whilst there are some items which are mandatory (listed above) there are others which can be left at home. Ensuring we only take what we need will increase our enjoyment of the trip in many ways.

Facilities

This is a Wild Expedition, there are none. This includes the fact that there are no toilet facilities. We will be required to go 'Au natural' and bury our waste in a latrine site in the sand. Please be prepared for this and also the good old British weather!
