Inclusivity and Additional Needs

Reach Outdoors welcomes all guests, regardless of perceived limitations and irrespective of special educational or medical needs, ethnic origin, gender or religion to take part in the Reach Outdoors experience (single activity or multi-day activity holidays).

Every effort will be made to ensure that taking part in single activities and multi-day activity holidays are available and accessible to all. There are some practical limits to what we can offer, and these are defined by:

Accommodation:

- If the accommodation access and approach is suitable.
- If the accommodation has accessible rooms and domestic facilities suitable for guests.

We will accept guests with all forms of additional physical needs but will expect them to bring appropriate carers and specialist equipment like hoists and specialist porta-loos etc if required.

Activities:

Where a guest can be accommodated, we can offer some activities, but the range of what we can offer is based on the guests' and carers' ability. For multi-day activity holidays every effort will be made to offer a varied and enjoyable activities list.

At Reach Outdoors, we are continually working to enable all guests to enjoy the many benefits of our activities. If a participant has additional requirements, we will be pleased to discuss these with you or arrange a visit.
